We've enjoyed being led this week in faith (our Mass this week - readers, servers, cantor & choir), academics and health and fitness! What an amazing year this is going to be!

We truly appreciate everyone doing their best to make drop off and pick up procedures run as smoothly as possible. Our number one priority is to keep your children safe. Thank you for working with us regarding the 7:25am drop off and 2:56pm pick up times. As stated in the Parent/Student Handbook and in our text message, students are not able to be supervised outside until 7:25am. If this time does not work, we do have Extended Care that opens at 6am to better service you. If you cannot pick up your child by 3:05pm, we will escort them to Extended Care. Please register online if you need this service before or after school.

Next week, our 3 and 4 year old preschoolers will be coming to school. This will add to the congestion at both the upper parking lot and the St. Joseph parking lot. Your patience is much appreciated as everyone learns the routine. We have the least amount of students riding the buses than ever before. This has added to the congestion. The St. Joseph Parking lot will open at 2:30pm each day. We have students out on the playground until then every day. The gate on Orchard Street will open as quickly as we can, ensuring the safety of all. If you want to visit with other children/parents, please come to the sidewalk so that we are able to move the traffic along. It's so good to see this happening again! We are confident as the year progresses, so too, will these procedures. Please check the school calendar for dates GB buses are not running. We will also send out a text reminder. We had our first Fire Drill this week. It was as if the students had never left! We evacuated the building in 59 seconds! (Our goal is 1 minute or less.) This drill along with all other safety drills are required. When we have Lockdown drills, we will send a message on the days those occur. All of our drills are posted within 30 days of occurrence on our website as required.

The GCHD has released an updated Covid toolkit for schools. There are very few changes from the guidance used at the end of last school year.

- If you are sick please stay home.
- It is recommended that if you are exposed to Covid by someone in your home you mask for 10 days and take a Covid test on day 5 after exposure.
- If you test positive for Covid you must stay home for 5 days.
- It is required upon return to school the student or staff will wear a mask for days 6-10.
- Holy Family is required to notify GCHD of a Covid positive student or staff member.
