If 2nd Grade student has younger siblings, those younger siblings will be gathered by a Holy Family School Staff member, and walk out to the parking lot to meet you. (3rd/4th Grade siblings will be escorted to this parking lot by a teacher.) Older siblings (Grades 5-8) will leave out the door at the end of the 2nd Grade hallway and walk down the stairs to meet you.
