Powers Bowling Coach, Mr. Matthew Wheeler

Powers Catholic Bowling Coach, Mr. Matthew Wheeler, would like to promote the Middle school bowling season. He is trying to build a sustained program at Powers Catholic and needs to have students start bowling before their freshman

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year. Here are a few points Coach Wheeler wants to share with our parents and students in Grades 6-8:

- The number of bowlers at the high school level has increased and Powers is able to field their first JV boys team in program history this year! We want to continue with that success. After next season the program will lose 3 girls (half the team) and 4 boys.
- There are more opportunities for kids to earn scholarship money in bowling, ESPECIALLY for girls, than there is in any other sport.
- We are lucky enough to bowl in the most highly recruited state in the country, thanks to the successful bowling programs around us. Michigan is the number one state for putting out collegiate bowlers.
- We just had one of our girls win the program's first state title!
