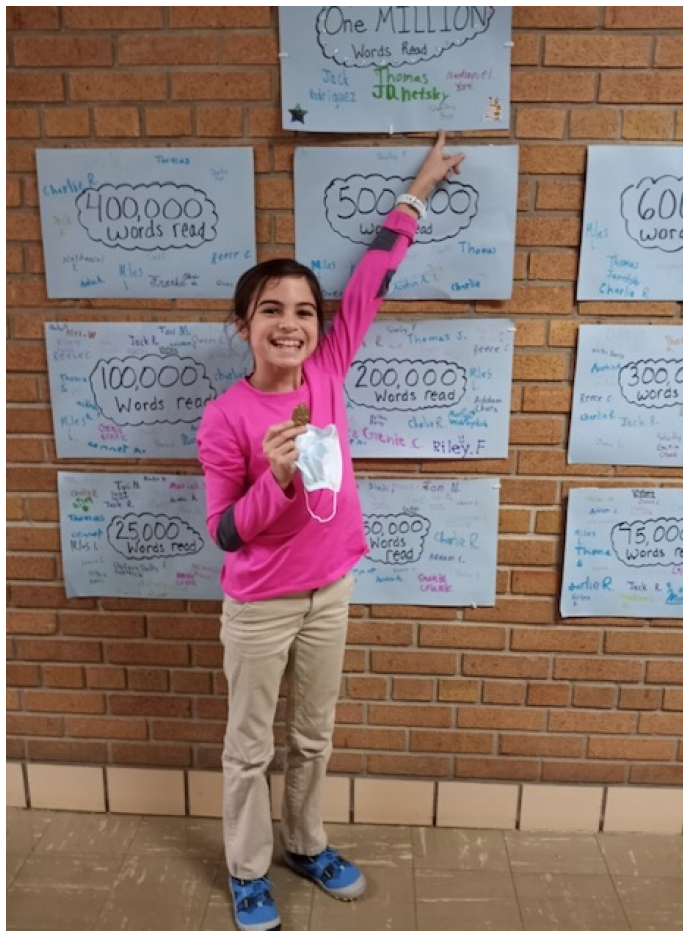

Powers Catholic Bowling Coach, Mr. Matthew Wheeler, would like to promote the Middle school bowling season. He is trying to build a sustained program at Powers Catholic and needs to have bowling before their freshman year. Here are a few points Coach Wheeler wants to share with our parents and students in Grades 6-8:

- The number of bowlers at the high school level has increased and Powers is able to field their first JV boys team in program history this year! We want to continue with that success. At program will lose 3 girls (half the team) and 4 boys.
