## Preschool

Second Grade: Please check email from your child's teachers.

Third Grade: "Live" sessions. Please check email from your child's teacher.

Fourth Grade: "Live" sessions. Please check email from your child's teacher.

Fifth-Sixth Grades: "Live" sessions. Please check email from your child's teachers.

Seventh-Eighth Grades: "Live" sessions. Please check email from your child's teachers.

"Live" sessions have specified times for your child to attend virtually through Google Meets. Please refer to the email sent from your child's teachers. Needed supplies/books were sent home with your child today. If your child was absent today, please plan to make arrangements to pick up these needed supplies.
