This week's virtue/characteristic: Forgiveness

Role Models (Saints known for this virtue.): St. Patrick, Bl. Margaret of Castello, St. Josephine Bakhita

Why does forgiveness matter? Forgiveness is the ability to move past being hurt by someone. By forgiving someone, you don't have to say that what the other person did was okay. Forgiveness allows you to let go of the hurt and move forward.

Goal: Think of a friend or classmate with whom you recently had a disagreement. Try to put yourself in their shoes and try to understand their perspective. Understanding someone else's perspective does not give them permission to hurt you. However, it may help you to forgive them and move forward.

Remember, a person can demonstrate forgiveness every single day!


