Principal Report: (Theresa Purcell)

- As of right now, we have 405 students enrolled at HFS. That is 35 less than last year. 54 students are virtual. 23 is max for a regular classroom with social distancing. Our first full week went well!
- Spirit wear and P2 shirts arrived today! Spirit wear was sent home today and P2 will be sent home tomorrow.
- NWEA started this week for our 3-6 graders. It is going very well! We should have the testing done by the end of this week.
- Absences: Families are doing a great job reporting if a kid is sick. Thank you! There was
 a Diocesan meeting with our school superintendent. There have been 7 cases of covid
 so far in the diocese and 3 among staff and teachers. Information goes out with the
 health department and naming where those cases have happened. We will keep you all
 informed. There has been minimal disruption within those schools that have had it.

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- Sports update: We sadly decided not to participate in football this year. We would have
 to form all the area Catholic schools together to make one team and if there is one case
 of Covid then we may have to close all schools. This will not change the rest of our
 sports. Cross country started today. More info on sports to come!
- Grand Blanc and some other area public schools will start to transition to start in person. What it means for bussing is unsure right now.
- Unfortunately, we will have to continue to have no volunteers in the school. It is part of our safety protocols.
