Tuesday, August 22, is the FIRST DAY of school for students in Kindergarten Prep through 8th Grade. The school will open at 7:20 AM. Please do not drop off your child(ren) prior to that time. There will be no adult supervision.

Morning Drop Off

We use curb side drop off for morning arrival. We ask that students exit the side of the car closest to the sidewalk. A separate email will be sent with a photo of this procedure. Approximately 7 cars should be unloading at the same time for each line.

All Second Grade students and siblings are to use the St. Joseph lot next to the playground. All students will walk up the steps and into the building.

KINDERGARTEN ONLY

On Tuesday, August 22, please park in the Father Bush Parking Lot (lower lot) and walk your kindergartner to the sidewalk where you child's teacher will be to take photos and meet other Kindergarten parents. After Tuesday, you will always use the upper lot to drop off your child(ren).

Afternoon Pick Up

ALL K-1, and 3-8 will be dismissed to the upper lot beginning August 22. Please park your car and wait patiently. Gate will not be opened until all students are clear of the sidewalk. K-1 parents, please park and walk over to the sidewalk near the flagpole. K-1 students will wait with a teacher. When they see their parent, they will let the teacher know, the teacher will make eye contact with you, and student will give teacher "high five" before they walk to you.

ALL Second Grade students and siblings can be picked up in the St. Joseph Center lot. (near playground)
