



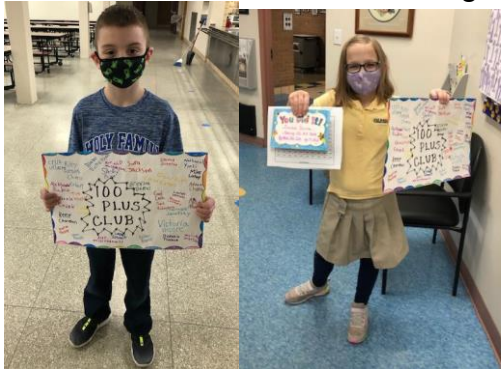

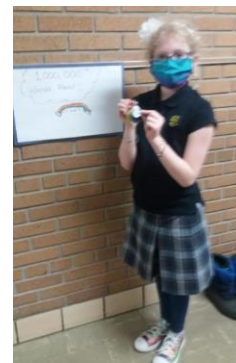
Dear Parent/Guardian,

REMINDERS:

Oh my have we grown this year! Parents, PLEASE take a look at the length of your daughter's skirts, especially those in 5th-8th Grade. "Pants/Crop Pants/Shorts/Skorts/Skirts/Jumpers Shorts should have an inseam of at least 5 inches. Skorts, skirts, and jumpers should be **knee length - width of a 3x5 card from top of knee to the hem.** Please check often, as students are growing. Uniform crop pants and shorts may be worn September through October, and April through June." (HFS Student-Parent Handbook, p. 28) We appreciate your help in promoting modesty.

Also, a reminder to all students and families regarding hair. "Hair should be clean, groomed and not cover a student's face or cause a distraction. Bangs should not obstruct vision. They should be kept short or pulled back. Distractions include, but are not limited to unnatural hair color (Blue, pink, etc.) or haircuts such as mohawks, etc. Boy's hair must be **cut above the eyes and off the collar.** Young men should be clean shaven."
