






The Genesee County Health Department announced this week that the mask mandate for students in Grades K-12 will be lifted on December 22, 2021. In my GCCS meeting yesterday, the GCHD informed the area superintendents that they would be making changes to the School Toolkit, including quarantine guidelines, and release those the first week in December.
