#### **Back to Ancient Times**

Our 7th grade students took a step back in time and participated in one of the oldest forms of writing...cuneiform. This style of writing was used in 3200 B.C. by the Sumerians. People used a stylus made from a reed and made marks on a clay tablet. Its significance is the key to understanding cultural activities in the ancient Near East.

Students enjoyed this ancient writing activity. "We were impressed by the combination of lines and shapes that represented many objects, " said Alexa and Grace. Maria added, "This system is complex. I'd be one of the strongest people around if I had to do my homework on THESE tablets!"
